### **COVID-19 Update for the 2020 Golf Season – Updated May 20, 2020**

The safety of our Pass Holders, Guests, and Staff is always our highest priority. We have implemented, and will be strictly enforcing, additional measures and precautions, as mandated by provincial regulation.

#### **PRIOR TO ARRIVING AT THE GOLF COURSE:**

- If you are sick or feeling sick, do not come to the golf course. Any player experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 will not be allowed to play and will be asked to leave the property in accordance to provincial regulation.
- Advance tee time reservations are required; no walk-on play will be permitted until further notice. Tee times may be booked online at [www.cookegolf.ca](http://www.cookegolf.ca) or over the phone (306)763-2502.
- Tee times have been spaced 12 minutes apart in accordance to provincial regulations.
- Bookings of 2, 3 and 4 golfers will be allowed. Single players will be able to book into groups if there is space with a previously booked twosome or threesome online.
- The driving range is available on a first come first served basis.

#### **UPON ARRIVAL AT THE GOLF COURSE:**

- There will be a starter/greeter positioned in front of the clubhouse to monitor arrivals, check you in and answer any questions. Golfers will be able to access first tee area and putting green no earlier than 15 min prior to your tee time.
- Only four customers will be permitted in the Pro Shop at one time.
- The clubhouse and common spaces (decks, patio) will be closed. The washroom will be accessible to registered golfers only. Only 1 person will be allowed to enter the washroom at a time.
- The beverage cart will not be on the course in accordance to provincial regulations.
- The washrooms on the course must remain closed in accordance to provincial regulations.
- The driving range and practice greens will be open. Physical distancing of 2M/6FT must be maintained at all times.
- Walking is encouraged. Pull carts and rental clubs will be available and will be sanitized between each use.
- All golf carts will be thoroughly sanitized before they are set up in the staging area. Only one golfer and one set of clubs will be permitted on each power cart unless the two riders are from the same household as per provincial regulations. This includes privately owned golf carts.

- Please ensure the group in front of you has left the tee box before making your way there, all groups must wait until their assigned tee time before teeing off – no exceptions!
- Scorecards and pencils will be made available upon request.

#### **ON THE GOLF COURSE:**

- Physical distancing of 2M/6FT is required at all times while on the property.
- Only touch your own personal items and golf equipment.
- The flag must remain in the cup at all times. Please no touching of the flagstick. Styrofoam device will be used to keep the ball from falling to the bottom of the cup.
- All high touch points have been removed from the golf course. Rakes and ball washers have been removed. Please play preferred lies in the bunker.
- We ask that you forgo the traditional after round handshake, and invite you to create your own physical distanced salutation.
- Garbage cans at tee sites have been removed. Garbage cans will be located at the clubhouse and outside the washrooms on holes 5 & 14. Please dispose of your garbage in the appropriate location.

#### **AFTER COMPLETING YOUR ROUND:**

- All power and pull cart rental equipment must be returned immediately to the appropriate return area. Please remove any refuse and deposit into garbage can in the return area.
- Until further notice all golfers are required to exit the facility immediately after completion of their round, no congregating will be permitted in / around the clubhouse or in the parking lot.

These are our rules and regulations to start the season and they will be amended as we progress through the 2020 season as directed by the Provincial Government. They are being strictly enforced for your safety and that of our staff, their families and the general public at large.

We thank you for your patience and understanding during this extraordinary time. Our staff is working diligently to provide the best possible experience for our customers in an unprecedented situation. We look forward to seeing you very soon.
